Scientific interests:

- 1) Chemical synthesis, characterization and applications of modified oligonucleotides and of novel modified nucleosides with potential antiviral, antitumour or anticoagulant activity.
- 2) Chemical synthesis of glycoconjugates as drug carriers and prodrugs for *in vivo* applications.
- 3) Chemical synthesis and characterization of peptido- and glycomimetics;
- 4) Chemical synthesis and characterization of nucleolipid-based ruthenium complexes as potential anticancer agents.
- 5) Studies on the interactions of potential drugs with nucleic acids.

She has been supervisor of several master theses in Chemistry and in Biology, as well as of PhD theses in Organic Chemistry at University of Napoli Federico II.

She is co-author of 104 scientific articles, published in international, peer-reviewed journals, 5 reviews, 3 book chapters as well as of more than 100 poster and oral communications presented at international symposiums and conferences.

She is one of the co-founders of *Women in Science in Naples*, an association born in 2007 from the initiative of a group of researchers in Federico II University, SUN (Seconda Università di Napoli), INFN and CNR, aimed at promoting equal opportunities in scientific research and academia.
